Responding to the respective aims and concerns of both Tanja Beer's *Ecoscenography: an introduction to ecological design for performance*, and the Theatres Trust and ABTT's *The Theatre Green Book* project, this panel invites presentation of publications ranging from papers, blogs and chapters to manuals and resource lists, in order to consider individual eco-practice as well as the collaborative approaches of increasing numbers of performance companies and suppliers. Our focus on 'works in progress' is a reflection of the ongoing research, development and experiment in this area, as well as the 'reflection-in and on action' essential to all areas of design and making for performance. This Panel connects with the Eco-Lounge initiative of the SBTD Sustainability Working Group from the UK which will showcase Sustainable Practice resources and publications of all scales and styles.

To facilitate participation from a variety of different contexts and locations, presentations may be in-person or live/recorded. Proposals are welcomed in the form of abstracts of up to 300 words, or visual descriptions in ppt form. Please only email documents/ppts under 5mb.
